Due to COVID-19, a **mandatory** 14-Day Temperature/Symptom Log must be completed daily for 14 days prior to the beginning of camp and must be submitted at registration. A screening will also be conducted prior to registration at the camp. Any camper with symptoms noted on that form or on the screening the day of camp, cannot be registered to attend camp. As we move forward, we will update you with any relevant changes due to CDC guidelines or Governor mandates. Any policy changes will be posted on the website.
