The campaign will provide a home environment for over 210 women (and their children) who are battling addiction. The offering this year will be to purchase school supplies for the children who will be in residence there. If you would like to contribute to this ministry, please let the Camp Director know. Last year the HUP facility for women and children, had not opened yet, so we were able to bless fifty children at Deep Creek Elementary School in Essex, MD. Each child received a backpack filled with school supplies and a NAMB coloring book.

The registration and payment must be received by the **June 18, 2022**, deadline. **Please fill out separate forms for each attendee.**

Check in is at **10 am, Thursday July 14, 2022**. The closing ceremonies for camp is **12:00 pm on Friday, July 15, 2022**.

We will be doing everything possible to ensure the safety of everyone who enters the camp. The guidelines concerning COVID are a part of the registration for camp. A screening will also be conducted prior to registration at the camp. Any camper with symptoms noted on the Health Questionnaire and Medical Release form, cannot attend camp.
